Horses need to eat and drink. They also need tack (saddles and bridles, etc), to have their feet trimmed at regular intervals and have veterinary care as and when they need it.

The humans on the ride need food, water, clothing and a tent or hammock to sleep in. As the organisers have been advised that the horses will not be able to survive on the available grazing along the route, they have purchased a support vehicle, which will bring food and water to the expedition on a daily basis.

All this has to be paid for. To date, apart from the fees the riders are paying to take part on the ride, these costs have been met by the organisers from their own funds.
